 (If you haven't read the sermon yet, do so to understand the comments in full context.) Another way to fairly and evenly share all responsibilities (fiscal and in-kind) with a spouse/partner/etc is to equate chore/work-time with money. So, you contribute 70% of \$ OR housework.

 In a 4 person household where 2 adults shared all in-kind and fiscal responsibilities prior to children reaching contributing age of ability, once children reach said age redistribute in-kind evenly. So, in such case, all do 25% of chores/housework.

 Now, where one adult/parent does 100% of the fiscal responsibility and the other adult/parent starts with 100% of the in-kind responsibility, with 2 kids the in-kind parent now does 50% and kids each do 25%.

 Allowances should be used as a teaching tool so everyone understands the value of their labor and any lack of allowances could be described thus: 20 hours of housework x \$32=\$640, cost of field trip=\$300, cost of soccer uniform=\$100, cost of broken vase=100, you get \$140 or like.

 One example I know of in deciding allowances for children is to reward for good grades. This family rewarded A's with \$50 each and B's with \$25 each and C-F's didn't earn anything. I'd suggest a variation of that as sole basis for allowances for school age kids.
